# LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

Sponsored by MTSBOA

## PURPOSE

The Leadership Scholarship is awarded annually to encourage and support a young musician in their pursuit of a higher education.

## AWARD

The MTSBOA will award one \$800.00 scholarship each year. The award will be divided into two equal payments and will be made directly to the college or university, once enrollment has been verified, at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters of his or her freshman year.

## ELIGIBILITY

- ✍ Applicants must be a student in their senior year of high school and attend a college or university the following fall semester.
- ✍ Applicants must be nominated by his or her music director. Directors are limited to one nomination from their program.
- ✍ Applicants must meet the eligibility requirements as set forth in section V of the MTBOA Constitution and By-Laws.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applicants must submit a completed application form, director nomination form, and a 300 – 500 word essay. The topic of the essay should be “how music education has affected my life”. Applicants should describe how studying music and being a member of their school music program has impacted their life and prepared them for the future. Essays will be reviewed under anonymity; applicants should refrain from referring to their school and director by name. Applicants should include their name at the top of the essay.

## DEADLINE

All materials must be postmarked no later than February 1, 2010 or may be submitted by the applicant’s teacher at the February MTSBOA meeting. Materials should be sent to MTSBOA Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 147, Cunningham, TN 37052.

# MUSICIANSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

## PURPOSE

The Musicianship Scholarship is awarded annually to encourage and support a young musician in their pursuit of a music education.

## AWARD

The MTSBOA will award one \$1,600.00 scholarship each year. The award will be divided into two equal payments and will be made directly to the college or university, once enrollment has been verified, at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters of his or her freshman year.

## ELIGIBILITY

- ✍ Applicants must be a student in their senior year of high school and attend a college or university the following fall semester with a declared major or minor in music.
- ✍ Applicants must meet the eligibility requirements as set forth in section V of the MTBOA Constitution and By-Laws.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applicants must submit a completed application form and a CD or cassette tape recording. The recording should be three to six minutes in length with the applicant performing a solo, movement from a concerto, or etudes of contrasting styles. Accompaniment is recommended but is not a requirement.

The CD or cassette tape must be clearly marked with the applicants name and compact discs must be playable on a standard CD player. Application materials including the recording will not be returned to the applicant.

## DEADLINE

All materials must be postmarked no later than February 1, 2010 or may be submitted by the applicant's teacher at the February MTSBOA meeting. Materials should be sent to MTSBOA Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 147, Cunningham, TN 37052.
