

Mid-State Audition Reminders

Please go over all information in this packet and share with your students.

Scale Barrier: (Please be sure to tell your students!!!) This past Fall the Association revised the Scale Barrier for **Senior High Auditions only**. The policy is: Senior High Students will perform the audition as follows: Scales, Sight Reading, and Prepared. If a student's combined Scale score from both judges is below 18, they will be dismissed from the audition and will not be allowed to perform Sight-Reading and Prepared. **Sr. High point distribution will be as follows:**

Chromatic (8 pts), 2 Major Scales (4 pts each), and Technical Excellence Points (4 pts)---Zero points for scale not meeting minimum requirements. This eliminates the possibility of a student playing only a portion of the required scales. *Scales should be played Quarter Note= mm 120 per scale degree minimum.*****

Percussion Fundamental Barrier: In 2004 the Association enacted the Fundamentals Barrier for Senior High Auditions only. The policy is: **Students must have a combined Fundamentals score of 36 to proceed to Sight-Reading and Prepared.**

Note: All late auditions must take place no later than 30 minutes after the section has completed try-outs.

Concessions: The McGavock Band Parents work very hard to provide a full menu of concessions for the students the day of each audition. **This is the only money we make for hosting these auditions so please encourage your students to visit our concession stand regularly.**

Distribute maps to students!!! Jr. High maps are most important to avoid disturbances with ACT testing held at McGavock on December 13, 2008.
